REVELATION'S "BEATITUDES"

Rev 1:3 – Blessed is he that readeth, and they that hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written therein: for the time is at hand.

Rev 14:13 – Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth: Yea, saith the Spirit, that they may rest from their labours; and their works do follow them. {cf John 5:24, 25; 6:40b; 11:25} – Look up these verses, they each give insight into this verse in connection with the corresponding verse, 20:6.}

Rev 16:15 – Behold, I come as a thief. Blessed is he that watcheth, and keepeth his garments, lest he walk naked, and they see his shame.

Rev 19:9 – Blessed are they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb. And he saith unto me, These are the true sayings of God.

Rev 20:6 – Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power...

Rev 22:7 – Behold, I come quickly: Blessed is he that keepeth the sayings of the prophecy of this book.

In Summary, all these 'beatitudes' can be bound up in this 7th beatitude.

Rev 22: 14 – Blessed are they that do His commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life and may enter in through the gates into the city.
