

# The Sanctuary – Preparation for the Giving of the Decalogue

## ST Series 23

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Just three months after leaving Egypt, the children of Israel came to the wilderness of Sinai. In this lesson we will note the typology of the experiences they went through to our Christian experience. This is necessary in our run up to the event which God used to establish Israel as a nation. Before we can effectually consider the “brief, comprehensive and authoritative” words of the covenant of God, we must prepare as did the Israelites for this grand experience.

We will thus consider carefully under the instruction of the Holy Spirit the words of Exodus 19. But first let us recall the events from the Passover to this time in Ex.19 and see how we can apply the lessons God has recorded in type for our admonition.
