This Chiastic structure is part of a larger reality, when looked at through the lens of the Great Controversy theme. Look for the Chiasm entitled, "IT IS FINISHED" (Great Controversy) for the larger picture on this subject. Very Enlightening!

The X refers to the shape of the chiasm from the Greek word "Chi", pronounced /Ki/, 22<sup>nd</sup> letter of the Greek alphabet, from which we get the word 'chiasm'.
