

Those Who will Dwell on High with Everlasting Burnings

Isaiah 33:2-16

A Remnant pleads the Lord's **Salvation** in the time of trouble their arm (defense). (vs.2)

Probation
Closes

B At the lifting up of Thyself –the nations fled. (vs.3)

C The Lord is **exalted**; for He **dwell**eth on **high**; (vs.3)

D He hath filled Zion with Judgment and righteousness.

D wisdom and knowledge the stability of thy times; (vs.6)

This will be a reality once probation closes. (see footnote below)

C strength of **salvation**: the fear of the Lord his treasure.

This should bring encouragement for God's people.

B Now will I rise, saith the Lord. Now will I be **exalted**; (vs.10)

Invitation given to each—near/far off to acknowledge God's strength/victory

A The Remnant dwelling on high (i.e. with the exalted Lord) place of defense, the munitions of rocks. (vs.15 & 16) [during time of trouble]

Tells who the remnant are

The Lord distinguishes, after vs.13, sinners in Zion (carnal Christians -5 foolish virgins) from the (remnant/144,000), those who walk uprightly in vs.14-16. When probation closes, the remnant will be filled with God's Judgment & Righteousness. They will be wise and the strength of salvation will be their's, because their Lord is exalted, esp. during the time of trouble. {cf. Rev 15:1, 6, 7; Isaiah 53:12; Daniel 12:2; Jeremiah 30:3, 10, 17, 22}
